Description

This document describes how to use the lccFileJumper-GUI.

The purposes of the program are:

- parse through small to very large files
- grab set amount of bytes
- jump to a specific place in a file
- find any content, including those with Carriage Return/Line Feeds
- keep history of past files

Installation

There is no installation. Just place the file on your machine and run.

Using

[menu] **Wrap Off**: turns the Content box text wrapping on/off.

[menu] **Settings**

[menu] **Edit**: edit the program settings.

[menu] **Reload**: reload the program settings.

[textbox] **Source Path**: the path of a file to open.

[button] **Browse**: find a file to open.

[button] **Get**: open the file in the Source Path box.

[section] **Stats**

[label] **Created**: the opened file' creation date/time.

[label] **Modified**: the opened file's modified date/time.

[label] **Size**: the opened file's size.

[label] **Grabbed**: how many bytes were grabbed. This may be less than the Grab amount if the file is smaller or you are near the end of the file and there are not enough bytes to retrieve the Grab amount.

[section] **Source Content**

[button] **Jump To**: jump to a specific character position.

[section] **Grab**

[button] | <: jump to the beginning of the file.

[button] <: jump backwards in the file the Grab amount.

[textbox] ###: the Grab amount.

[button] >: jump forwards in the file the Grab amount.

[button] > |: jump to the end of the file.

[button] <: jump backwards in the file the amount listed in the drop down.

[drop down list] ###: preset amounts to jump.

[button] >: jump forwards in the file the amount listed in the drop down.

[section] **Find**

[button] >

[button] **Reload**: reloads the current file using any current settings.

[button] **Open**

[section][tab] **Content**

[button] **Copy**: copy the content to the clipboard.

[button] **Save**: save the content to a file.

[section][tab] **Source Path History**

[button] **Retrieve**: retrieve a file from the Source Path History.

[table] Source Path History

...rows...: a list of past files loaded. When a file is chosen, it is automatically moved to the top of the list.
