Commencement Address

President Mary Cullinan

Eastern Washington University

Dr. Mary Cullinan has served as the 26th President of Eastern Washington University (EWU) since 2014. Prior to coming to Washington, she served for seven years as President of Southern Oregon University and for three years as Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs at Stephen F. Austin State University in Texas. From 1996 until 2003, Dr. Cullinan served as Dean of the College of Arts, Letters and Sciences and Professor of English at CSU Stanislaus. From 1981 until 1996, she held faculty and administrative positions at CSU East Bay (formerly CSU Hayward).



In her first years at EWU, President Cullinan has focused on creating stronger pathways for students through powerful collaboration with schools and community colleges, effective advising, mentoring, innovative curricula, and partnerships with local businesses and organizations. Her strong focus at EWU is providing access to diverse students and then ensuring that high quality academic programs and effective support systems move students smoothly toward a degree.

At Southern Oregon University, President Cullinan strengthened partnerships with Rogue Community College. Together, the university and the community college opened the first LEED Platinum building in southern Oregon, the Higher Education Center.

Under her leadership at Southern Oregon University, a public-private partnership led to a 700-bed residence and dining hall (LEED Gold), the largest building project ever in Ashland. During her years at SOU, the university opened innovative academic programs such as Emerging Media and Digital Arts, Bachelor of Applied Science, and Outdoor Adventure Leadership that respond to workforce needs and student interests. She also provided leadership to create an Honors College, with each student paired with a community mentor, that opened in 2013.

Dr. Cullinan received her B.A. *magna cum laude* from the University of Pennsylvania and her M.A. and Ph.D. in English Literature from the University of Wisconsin. She is the author of books on business communication and a biography of Scottish author Susan Ferrier. She co-edited an anthology, *American Women Writers: Diverse Voices in Prose Since 1845*. She has served on the Board of Directors for the American Association of State Colleges and Universities, the Council of Public Liberal Arts Colleges, and other national and regional organizations.

A Brief History of Academic Dress

Academic dress evolved over many years from the robes worn by medieval students, usually clerics in the cathedral schools and monasteries established by the Catholic Church. In 1321, the University of Coimbra began requiring its faculty to wear gowns (most likely for warmth in the unheated medieval buildings). Later the various colleges of the University of Cambridge adopted specific styles and color combinations for its faculties. On May 26, 1895, institutional representatives met at Columbia University to establish a uniform code for U.S. academic attire.

The hood bears the colorful standard of academic symbolism, revealing the level of the degree, the academic field of learning in which the degree was earned, and the institution that conferred the degree.

Made of the same material as the gown, the hood varies in length from 3 feet for the bachelor's degree, to 3.5 feet for the master's and 4 feet for the doctoral degrees. The color or colors of the lining of the hood indicate the institution that conferred the degree. The hood is trimmed or edged in a border either two, three, or five inches wide for the respective degrees. The border color represents the faculty or field of study in which the degree was awarded.

Approved cap of the academic costume is the mortarboard, a stiff 9-inch square on a soft cap made of the same cotton poplin or spun rayon as the gown. Velvet material is reserved for the Doctor's degree. A silk cord with tassel is attached to the button in the center of the board. The length of the cord and tassel may vary with the degree of the wearer. The tassel and cord may be black for any degree, but only the Doctor may wear a gold metallic cord and tassel. The tassel may reflect the color of the field in which the degree was earned, and a few institutions use tassel colors to indicate academic honors.

2015–2016 Graduates

(HH) = Highest Honors: Students who have maintained a grade point average of 3.8 to 4.0 are awarded their degrees with the highest honors. Both Honors and High Honors graduates wear a gold cord.

(H) = Honors: Students who have maintained a grade point average of 3.5 to 3.79 are awarded their degrees with honors.

(PTK) = Phi Theta Kappa: LCC students with a grade point average of 3.5 or better are invited to join Phi Theta Kappa and remain members in good standing. Phi Theta Kappa members wear a gold stole.

(RS) = Running Start: These students are graduating from both LCC and their high school because they took LCC classes while still in high school.

Red, white and blue cords honor graduates who are **veterans**. We are grateful for their service.

A red/black cord indicates a **TRIO Student Support Services** graduate. Many are the first in their family to graduate from college.

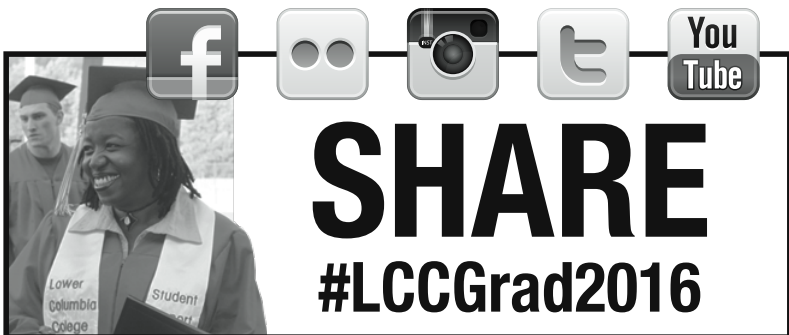
