Jennifer Blomgren was raised in Forks, in the heart of the Olympic rainforest. Her own early experiences inspired her two children's books.

*Where do I Sleep? A Pacific Lullaby* won a prize from the Pacific Northwest Booksellers Association in 2002. This "tranquil bedtime poem" features animals in their natural habitat, and introduces young children to the nature and geography of our region.

Her second children's book, *Where Would I Be in an Evergreen Tree?* gracefully shows an ancient tree's life cycle and many plants and animals that it supports.

Blomgren's own watercolors illustrate her most recent book, *The Tale of Alice's Quilt*, about a young girl who finds a stack of appliquéd quilt blocks, her first connection to a distant ancestor.
