



Nursing Required Support Courses

Required Support Courses (for AN-DTA) – Registered Nurse

The following courses with a grade of C (2.0) or above are required. However, you must meet the required *minimum 2.8 cumulative grade point* on the prerequisite and support courses.

No more than 10 credits may be from a single discipline in this distribution list.

In accordance with LCC's graduation requirements, all students must complete at least 4 credits of DIVERSITY (DIV) designated coursework prior to graduation. It is recommended that applicants address the DIVERSITY requirement by completing at least one course from the HUMANITIES distribution list that also carries the DIVERSITY designation.

Students applying to the nursing program are required to be current certified nursing assistants in Washington or Oregon, unless entering as a Licensed Practical Nurse.
