8. revise course	<b>MATH 220</b> , Linear Algebra	5 cr, 55 lec
<p><b>Rationale/Discussion:</b> Previously this course only transferred as matrix algebra. With the addition of new content and a stronger emphasis on linear algebra theory, this course now transfers as a 300 level math course and needs a higher prerequisite than Calculus 1. For example, integration is used to define an inner product on a vector space. Integration is taught in MATH 152. Distribution list will reflect Quantitative/Symbolic Reasoning. Global Skills will reflect Numeracy. Prerequisite now reads: MATH&amp; 152 with a grade of C or better.</p>

9. revise course	<b>MATH 050</b> , Review Math-Whole Numbers	1 cr, 22 lab (was 1 cr, 11 lec)
<p><b>Rationale/Discussion:</b> This is a course in basic arithmetic on whole numbers (no fractions, no decimals, and no negatives). The majority of the time needed in this course is for students to practice arithmetic and therefore there is little lecture happening in the classroom. In recent history this class has only been offered in a self-paced lab setting so the lecture Vs. lab credit issue did not come up. But, now that we are offering this in a more traditional face-to-face setting, it is clear that more seat time is needed. There is no additional content needed to necessitate more credits; there is just a need for more seat time.</p>
