<b>Proposal from Dawn Draus:</b>		
<b>A.</b>	Revise Course	<b>COLL 74</b> , Math Success (credits) 3 cr, 33 lec
<b>Rationale:</b> No longer need a 2 credit option as all pre-college math courses are now 3 credits.

<b>B.</b>	Revise Course	<b>POLS&amp; 202</b> , US Government (title) 5 cr, 55 lec
