<b>A.</b> New Course	<b>ENGL&amp; 112</b> , Intro to Fiction (new)	5 cr, 55 lec
<b>Rationale:</b> Study Abroad Class for Fall 2022 in Barcelona

<b>Proposals from Ann Williamson:</b>		
<b>B.</b> Revise Course	<b>EDUC 319</b> , Anti-Bias Education (distribution)	5 cr, 55 lec
<b>Rationale:</b> This proposal is seeking to add EDUC 319 to the Social Science Distribution List and has received SS department support and approval. Only students in the BAS-TE program will be taking this course.
